Eligibility for graduation requires:

- 1) Satisfactory completion of courses printed below;
- 2) A minimum total of 24 graduate semester hours earned at The College of New Jersey
- 3) A cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0
- 4) Completion of all departmental requirements/prerequisites
- 5) A grade of B or better in all required coursework. Students who receive a grade of B-, C+, C or C- in a required course will be permitted to retake the course(s) in question only once to improve their grade and remain in the program. Failure to obtain a B or better in the second attempt will result in automatic termination.
- 6) A student receiving an "F" grade in any course will automatically be denied continuance in the Department of Counselor Education program.
